HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Dennie stated that the sand and salt are doing really well. They only had to order salt once. The culverts that were ordered last year still have not come arrived. They may be available by March. We had to replace a couple of key parts for the sewer system. The parts well out lasted their expected lifetime. The garage doors at the shop need to be replaced. We received an estimate for the electric opener for \$1795.00 and the door replacement for \$2698.00. The doors have become a hazard that needs to be repaired. The crew has been cutting brush and repairing water leaks. Councilperson Brankman asked how the new excavator was working out. Dennie said its going really well.
