

Planning Board Minutes
January 24, 2018

Chairman Chris Maron called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Dwight Anson, Ms. Cynthia Fairbanks, and Ms. Mary Lou Fitzgerald.

Chairman Maron: We have a pretty short agenda. It's just to approve the officers for the coming year, look at our schedule, approve the minutes from February 22, and any other business that might be in line. Are there any comments from our esteemed committee?

Ms. Fitzgerald: Julie has made up this schedule for the year and I think she changed the dates around the holidays in November and December.

Chairman Maron: That's fine I think, especially if we're not meeting very often. I wonder when Thanksgiving is that year; it must be early.

Ms. Fitzgerald: If you're ready for it, I'll move to approve the minutes of February 22.

Chairman Maron: Is there a second?

Chairman Maron: We have nominated: Me as chairman, Alan as vice chairman, and Julie as secretary.

Ms. Fairbanks: I'll second.

Chairman Maron: All in favor, no opposition, carried.
It seems that's almost it. Other business, I guess I will bring up one thing. It dates back from when Bill was the chair and we were going through some amended town plan. When I became chair, we looked at it a little bit and then we were either busy or didn't

really tend to it. I'm not sure where that stands – if the town is still considering it or if we should be looking into that.

Mr. Anson: Probably should be looking into it.

Ms. Fitzgerald: We have to say something before the town can act on it. That's the last I heard.

Chairman Maron: Ok, I'll ask.

Ms. Fitzgerald: We don't know if the town is interested in it or not.

Chairman Maron: Okay. I'll ask George or Ike.

Ms. Fitzgerald: Is that town law?

Chairman Maron: It's the town law.

Ms. Fairbanks: It does seem like it would be a good thing to try to get done.

Ms. Fitzgerald: Some of that was coordinating the old town law with the village law – to try to compose one instead of having parts of each.

Chairman Maron: I'll ask and see if it's something we can dig into. Is there anything else people have on their minds?

Ms. Fitzgerald: I told Julie I like the idea of calling us to remind us that there is a meeting. We can say to her whether we can make it or not. If that doesn't work for everyone, others can use a different way.

Chairman Maron: I think we'll do both. We'll have her call and she or I will send out an email.

Mr. Anson: For me, I think the best is to call.

Ms. Fitzgerald: I move we adjourn.

Chairman Maron: Second? Cynthia seconds. All in favor? Meeting adjourned 7:07 p.m.
