

Planning Board Public Hearing
March 27, 2019

Chairman Chris Maron called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Dwight Anson, Ms. Cynthia Fairbanks, Ms. Mary Lou Fitzgerald, and Mr. Ken White. Also in attendance was Mr. George Hainer, Building Codes/Zoning Officer. Guests in attendance: David Langston and Steve Denton.

Chairman Maron: This is a public hearing of the Planning Board. The hearing will address the Special Permit application submitted by Camp Dudley Inc. to construct a climbing tower. The Planning Board will hear all persons interested in the subject matter thereof. I invite you to summarize your project and we'll see if there are any comments.

Mr. David Langston: The project remains the same as it was presented. It is a commemorative climbing tower that will be just under 40 feet tall. It's designed as a recreational facility at Camp Dudley to support our use at camp, but can also be used by residents of the community – school groups may use it. It can be used on a year round basis. It will be located in the vicinity of our basketball courts and will be used by trained staff. I'd be happy to provide any other details.

Mr. White: I feel that all of our questions were answered last month; there's no one here from the public to question it.

Ms. Fitzgerald: I agree with that.

Mr. White: I would move we move forward.

Chairman Maron: Ken moves to close the hearing. Is there a second?

Ms. Fitzgerald: I second.

Chairman Maron: Any discussion? All in favor? The hearing is closed at 7:03 p.m.
